**Auditions:** If you are interested in auditioning for theatre or music, or in submitting a portfolio to the art department, you must do the following:

1. Complete the registration form found in this brochure.

2. Carefully follow the directions outlined for each program. Each department has different requirements for its competition.

3. Submit all registration and audition materials to the Music Department and/or Theatre Department no later than November 11, 2004, for the November 20 audition date, or no later than January 20, 2005, for the January 29 audition date.

If you are auditioning for music or theatre, you will be contacted to confirm your audition time after we receive your registration form, audition form and supporting materials.

Please note: Students may audition for an award in more than one department; however, all guidelines must be followed for the individual departments concerned. Students must apply for admission to Rhodes by January 15, 2004, to be eligible to receive a Fine Arts Award. Do not include registration, audition forms, letters of recommendation specific to the competition or slide submissions in your application for admission.



If a student qualifies for a Fine Arts Award and another competitive scholarship, only one scholarship (whichever is greater) will be awarded.

# INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES IN MUSIC

If you are interested in auditioning in music, please prepare two brief compositions of contrasting style or period. Piano and vocal audition material must be memorized. Instrumentalists must be prepared to play any portion of their audition material. An accompanist is available, if needed. (Please bring sheet music in the correct key—taped accompaniment will not be accepted.) The audition and interview will last approximately fifteen minutes. Please complete the enclosed registration and audition forms. You must also provide two letters of recommendation concerning your performance ability. One recommendation should be from your current teacher, if you have one. All of these materials should be received by the Music Department no later than November 11th, 2004, for the November 20 audition date, or January 20, 2005, for the January 29 audition date. ## INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES IN THEATRE

If you are interested in auditioning in theatre, with an emphasis in performance, please prepare one monologue from a contemporary play and one monologue from a classic play, choosing characters close to your own age and experience. Each monologue should be no more than three minutes in length and one selection should be humorous. If you are interested in auditioning in theatre, with a design or technical emphasis, please prepare a design (set, lights, or costumes) for a play and be prepared to discuss your design choices. You should also bring a collection of your art work and other designs, if you have some. Be prepared to discuss your work in technical theatre. In addition, ALL students auditioning in theatre (with either a performance or a technical/design emphasis) should complete the registration and audition forms. You must also provide two letters of recommendation concerning your performance/design ability. One recommendation should be from your current teacher, if you have one. All of these materials should be received by the theatre department no later than November 11, 2004, for the November 20 audition date, or January 20, 2005, for the January 29 audition date.
