March 18, 2009-Natasha Richards, star of stage and screen, dies of complications following a skiing accident.

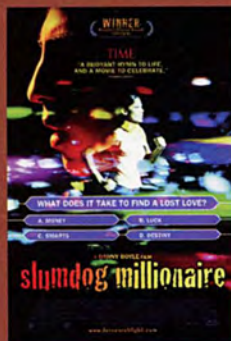
