Arnie Pittman '67 – Outstanding golfer for the Lynx who served as team captain his junior and senior years

David Maddux '87 – Selected All College Athletic Conference (All CAC) in 1984, 1985 and 1986 at defensive tackle

Thomas Johnson '94 – Outstanding scorer who led the Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference (SCAC) in scoring (486 points) and scoring average (19.4/game) his senior year

Albert Johnson '96 - Ranks as one of the best point guards in Rhodes basketball history

Emily Burch (Crocker) '01 – Put the Rhodes Women's Golf program on the map when she finished as the national runnerup in the 2001 NCAA Division III National Championship

Becky Harper (Dickey) '01 – Becomes the first Rhodes softball player to be inducted into the Athletic Hall of Fame
