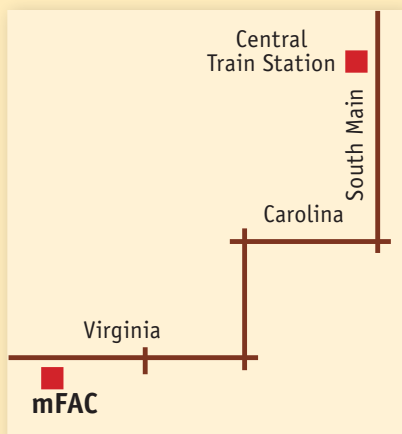

Laura Splan is currently an artist in residence at the Medicine Factory, and her work also is on view in "Pricked: Extreme Embroidery" at the Museum for Arts and Design in New York. She has had one-person shows at various venues including the International Museum of Surgical Science in Chicago and The New York Hall of Science. Splan holds an M.F.A. in Sculpture from Mills College (Oakland, CA) and a B.F.A. from the University of California, Irvine where she originally studied biological sciences. Botox parties, health epidemics, reality makeover shows, bio-terrorism, anti-microbial products, and pharmaceutical advertising all serve as inspiration for Splan's work. Her interest in medicine is evident in her art that often employs unsettling anatomical and medical imagery.



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
