- 2,641 students were accepted, or 49% of the applicant pool 582 students are committed to enroll this fall: 19 transfers and 563 first-year students




- 51% ranked in the top 10% of their class

- The middle 50% range of SAT scores is 1200 to 1360, and ACT, 27 to 31


Grade Point Average


