Monday, September 8, 2008 -- (Meditation: Acts 2:25-28)

Dear God, I praise You that there is no day without Your presence. I praise You that there is no challenge that I have to face alone. Friday, September 12, 2008 -- (Meditation: John 14-1-4)

She looks one last time at his coffin, and bends to touch him -- unanswered. God, embrace her grief, hold her close, dry her tears. Remind her that he is with You.
