Channel 5, 5'o clock "Action News". Excellent
coverage until the very end. Photos of
the park were excellent (I watched in color).
Dr. Smith (first name not correct!) stated that the state
had made no bona fide attempts at finding alternatives,
and that all presentations to Washington were
filtered thru the State. At close, Cox commented that
"only yesterday" he learned that the proceeds for repurposing
had been used for purchase of more parkland
especially in areas that sold. Questioned by Sylvia
Black (TV reporter), "Is that bad?", Cox smiled, "No,
it's very good. [misleading! Who rebutted that?]"

Channel 3, 6 P.M. (At 6, I saw only the end - at 10,
I believe the walk-thru-the-park segment was much
like the other two.) This station alone interviewed
Charles Newman, C-Pop attorney. Asked what
his clients would do if Adams ruled against
them, Newman replied that the law is clear, he
doesn't anticipate such a ruling.

Channel 13, 6 P.M. Shows ^{from} Cox walking
the bus lanes, with him was a tall, nice-looking
man I do not know. [This
coverage was the poorest: made much of "harm
to the gor animals!"
