

Memphis May 16/59

This Agreement made this sixteenth  
Day of May one Thousand Eight Hundred and  
Fifty Nine Between John Rix of the City of  
Memphis and County of Shelby and State  
of Tennessee of the first part and

John of the aforesaid City, County  
and State of the second part

Witnesseth that that said John Rix  
in consideration of the covenants on  
the part of the party of the second  
part hereinafter contained hath consented  
and agreed to and with the said

John to pave the sidewalk on  
Shelby Street in front of the Gayoso  
House (being in the city before mentioned  
) on any such part of same as shall  
be required with good and sound  
Ohio free stone of two and a half inches  
in the clemp of four size for the sum  
of forty cents per superficial foot  
and the said John Rix further agrees

to furnish and set in a good and  
substantial manner a Lead stone of  
not less than five inches thick and  
15 inches deep for the sum of one Dollar  
and fifty cents per serial foot

The party of the second part  
to remove the brick pavement and the  
old curbstane and also furnish sand  
for to lay the flagging in
