Sir  
We have just now shipped by the  
Hickman (which leaves today) The Lock, &c for the Sliding  
doors, also Eleven silver plated Bell pulls, which Mr  
Lockerd ordered, and charged the same to him as you will  
see by the enclosed bill.

We rec<sup>d</sup>. a letter from Et Hill dated the  
19<sup>th</sup> inst - stating you had ordered thirty four Brass Bolts the  
same size of those sent. we went to work at once on them. and  
had the Hickman remain until tomorrow we would have  
shipped them also - we will take as a favor if you will pay to  
him six dollars per week, and charge the same to us.

The Bolts which we made for the 4 Sliding doors are  
intended to be placed on the side of the door next to the centre  
Rail way - by that means the Bolts are hid, and at the same, when  
the centre doors are locked the Bolts cant be got at
