Not having heard from you since your favor of the 9th, which informed us, that you would make a remittance in a few days, we write hoping there has been no loss in sending it, as it has not reached us yet.

We contracted with the Elder to pay him Cash for the door and Member Plates as soon as they were done,

It is exceedingly difficult to collect money here, hence the desire to hear from you,

Mr. Kinsey has called to know if we have heard anything further about the Modelion (Casts)

We could not get Mr West to make out his Bid delivered at Memphis, as he had not the time to go to the wharf and did not seem willing ^{to take} our information
