

Rhodes Service Scholarship

Benefits

The **Rhodes Service Scholarship** is for students who have demonstrated an exceptional record of leadership and service participation in their communities and who wish to become effective leaders who promote positive change in the world.

- 15 scholarships awarded to first-year students each year
- Scholarships are valued at \$12,100 per year and are in addition to any Rhodes grant or scholarship the student may receive
- Service Scholars may also receive two \$2,500 earning and living stipends for community service initiatives performed during the summer

Expectations

- Be involved in community service and leadership programs for an average of ten hours a week during the academic year
- Complete two summers of full-time community service for a total of 280 hours over at least a seven-week period
- Participate in the Burch Leadership Program
- Participate in the Bonner Scholars service trip at the end of the student's first year at Rhodes
- Participate in the Bonner Scholars Cluster Event, a weekend trip to another college involving training and a service activity

Eligibility

- Complete an Application for Admission to Rhodes, with all materials submitted by January 15, 2003
- Rank in the top 15% of high school class (if ranked, or the equivalent performance in schools that do not rank)
- Demonstrate an outstanding record of leadership and service participation
- Have a gross family income of less than \$85,000 per year
- *All students who meet these eligibility requirements will be automatically considered for the scholarship*
