One game ended in a scoreless deadlock. The whole season was featured by exceptional play, and the deadly handicap was the woeful lack of reserves.





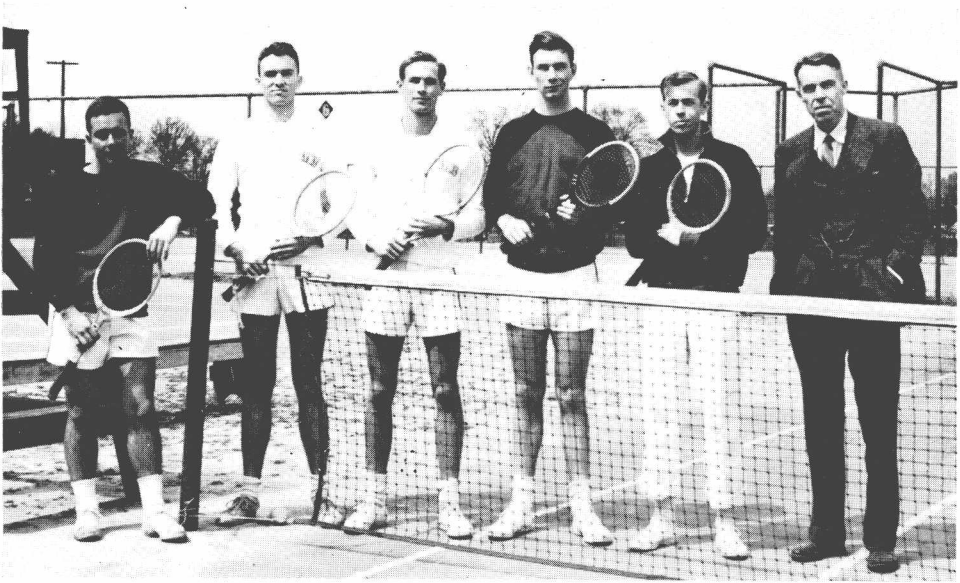
