## RHODES FINE ARTS FELLOWSHIPS

**Audition Dates:** Music: Saturday, January 20, 2007 and Saturday, February 10, 2007  
Theatre: Saturday, February 10, 2007  
Art: Slides due by Friday, January 12, 2007

**Award Values:** The eight awards are valued at \$12,500 per year.

**Award Conditions:** Award winners are required to make satisfactory progress towards a major or minor in art, music or theatre at Rhodes.

**Auditions:** If you are interested in auditioning for theatre or music, or in submitting a portfolio to the art department, you must do the following:

1. Complete the registration form found in this brochure.
2. Carefully follow the directions outlined for each program. Each department has different requirements for its competition.
3. Submit all registration and audition materials to the Music Department and/or Theatre Department no later than January 12, 2007.

If you are auditioning for music or theatre, you will be contacted to confirm your audition time after we receive your registration form, audition form and supporting materials.

**Please note:** Students may audition for an award in more than one department; however, all guidelines must be followed for the individual departments concerned. Students must apply for admission to Rhodes by January 15, 2006, to be eligible to receive a Fine Arts Fellowship. Do not include registration, audition forms, letters of recommendation specific to the competition or slide submissions in your application for admission.

If a student qualifies for a Fine Arts Fellowship and another competitive scholarship, only one scholarship or fellowship (whichever is greater) will be awarded.

## **INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES IN MUSIC**

Music Auditions on January 20, 2007 and February 10, 2007

If you are interested in auditioning in music, please prepare two brief compositions of contrasting style or period. Piano and vocal audition material must be memorized. Instrumentalists must be prepared to play any portion of their audition material. An accompanist is available, if needed. (Please bring sheet music in the correct key—taped accompaniment will not be accepted.) The audition and interview will last approximately fifteen minutes. Please complete the enclosed registration and audition forms. You must also provide two letters of recommendation concerning your performance ability. One recommendation should be from your current teacher, if you have one. All of these materials should be received by the Music Department no later than January 12, 2007. ## **INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES IN THEATRE**

Theatre Auditions on February 10, 2007

If you are interested in auditioning in theatre, with an emphasis in performance, please prepare one monologue from a contemporary play and one monologue from a classic play, choosing characters close to your own age and experience. Each monologue should be no more than three minutes in length and one selection should be humorous. If you are interested in auditioning in theatre, with a design or technical emphasis, please prepare a design (set, lights, or costumes) for a play and be prepared to discuss your design choices. You should also bring a collection of your art work and other designs, if you have some. Be prepared to discuss your work in technical theatre. In addition, ALL students auditioning in theatre (with either a performance or a technical/design emphasis) should complete the registration and audition forms. You must also provide two letters of recommendation concerning your performance/design ability. One recommendation should be from your current teacher, if you have one. All of these materials should be received by the theatre department no later than January 12, 2007. ## CODA FINE ARTS FELLOWSHIPS

**Interview Dates:** Saturday, February 10, 2007

**Award Values:** \$12,500 per year.

**Award Conditions:** CODA (Center for Outreach in the Development of the Arts) Fine Arts Fellowships are made to students that demonstrate an interest and potential for personal leadership in any area of the Fine Arts. Award recipients participate in the CODA Fine Arts Leadership Program at Rhodes College, requiring 10 hours of weekly mentored leadership development and practical internship in a Fine Arts project.

**Interviews:** Selected applicants will be asked to interview at Rhodes College on February 10, 2007. The interview will probe the following areas:

1. Your interest in thinking analytically and critically about the Fine Arts;
2. Your experience and potential for leadership in the Fine Arts;
3. Your level of engagement in the Fine Arts.

**Please note:** While performance and participation may be a part of your experience in an area of the Fine Arts, the CODA Fine Arts Fellowships are not based upon performance in areas such as music, art, theater, dance, or other applied performance areas. The primary determination for CODA Fellows is based upon the potential for Fine Arts Leadership and the ability to think analytically and critically about the Fine Arts.
