


Fellowships

At Rhodes, we have taken traditional scholarships a step further by creating fellowships that allow students to invest in themselves through professional internships, community service, research, or other opportunities as part of their financial assistance.



The following fellowships are available for students entering Fall, 2008

3 Walter D. Bellingrath Fellowships

Equal to full cost of tuition, fees, room and board Four year value over \$150,000 each

5 Morse Fellowships

\$32,000 per year for four years

15 Cambridge Fellowships \$24,000 per year for four years

35 University Fellowships \$15,000 per year for four years

15 Ralph C. Hon Fellowships

\$15,000 per year for four years For students interested in economics, business, international studies, pre-med or pre-ministerial

50 Presidential Fellowships

\$12,500 per year for four years

50 Rhodes Awards

\$5,000 to \$10,000 per year for four years

10 Dean's Fellowships

\$15,000 to \$24,000 per year for four years Separately endowed for outstanding students of color

1 Taylor Fellowship in Physics

Up to \$15,000 per year for four years for students interested in Physics

8 Fine Arts Fellowships

\$12,500 per year for four years for students interested in studying art, music and theatre

4 CODA Fellowships

\$12,500 per year for four years for students with an interest and potential for leadership in the Arts

15 Bonner Service Scholarshins

\$12,100 per year in addition to other Rhodes grants and fellowships

1 to 3 Spencer Fellowships

\$2,000 to 3,000 per year for four years in addition to other grants or fellowships
