Like the prodigal son, "I am no longer worthy to be called Your child." Yet Your open arms bid me to come to You. I can feel Your loving embrace, Your forgiveness, Your "Welcome home my child!" Undeserving, I am forgiven. Unworthy, I am home. Forgiven, I praise You, O God! Amen.

Wednesday, July 2, 2008 -- (Meditation: Luke 18:15-17) God, when our daughter was just a toddler, and when her turn came to ask the blessing at mealtime, she would clasp her chubby little hands together, bow her head, close her eyes, and say, "Kank-kee God. 'Men." ("Thank You God. Amen".) What a wonderful and loving prayer. That is my prayer today. "God, thank you! Amen."

Thursday, July 3, 2008 -- (Meditation: Jeremiah 17:7) God, I want to entrust my future to You, but it is so hard to do. I know that worry is fundamentally a lack of trust, and I am trying to lay my anxieties at Your feet, but doubts arise about how You will handle them. God, forgive my doubts. Help me to let go and embrace You and Your will. In Jesus' name. Amen.

Friday, July 4, 2008 -- (Meditation: Hebrews 11:13-16) God, by Your guiding hand, our Nation's founders crossed the sea. Once settled in the new world, they worshipped You with prayers and psalms. They brought forth laws and freedom, through the truth of Your Word and their faith in You. They founded a nation under God, with liberty and justice for all. God, thank You for our nation and for her founders. In Jesus' name. Amen.
