- 4. What fuels your passion for this project?**

Please put in every effort to explain through your writing why giving you these funds will enrich your life or the lives of others.

Proposals are due January 21.

You will be notified of the committee's decision by February 15th. Committee decisions are final. Reimbursement requests are acceptable, but the student must have receipts and must have made the expenditure after August 15th, 2008.
