Admission Statistics

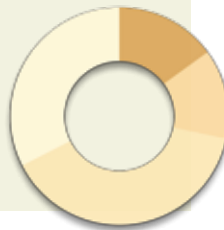
5,359 applications were received

51% ranked in the top 10% of their class

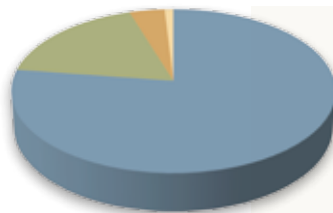
57% attended public high schools, 43% private high schools

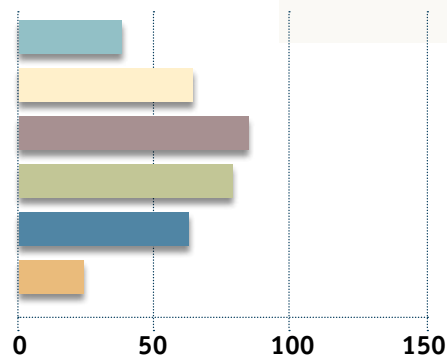

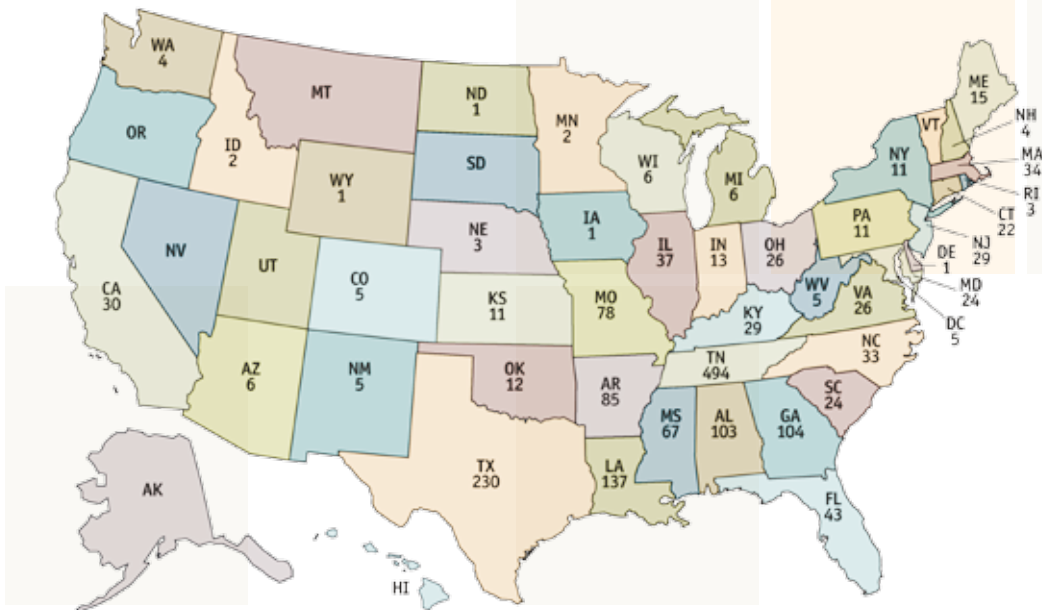
