The Committee authorized the following offer:

Dear Dr. Rosebro,

In view of the misinformation as to your salary when you first agreed to accept the chair of Theology here, it is with pleasure that I say to you that the Executive Committee will rent you the Chancellor's residence for fifteen dollars a month until July 1, 1909, subject to dispossession on thirty days notice in case it be needed for a Chancellor.

The reason why the limit of July first is out is that in case a Chancellor be elected for next session, it will be necessary probably to have the house overhauled during the summer.
