10 Is All Needed For Class In Southwestern

Southwestern's International Language Center will accommodate all who come in sufficient numbers, next semester, Dr. Joe O. Embry, director, says.

Dr. Embry said yesterday if as many as 10 people want instruction in a language the center will try to offer it.

"I believe we can find a qualified instructor for anything that 10 or more would want," he said.

The year-old center located in Southwestern's Mallory Gymnasium now offers night classes for adults in French, German, Russian and Spanish; even English, for foreigners. Instruction in 15 other languages is available by tape recordings.

Afternoon classes for children are also offered.

Registrations are now being taken for the second semester which starts Feb. 4.

Any language that 10 or more persons want to study will be taught next semester at Southwestern's International Language Center. There will be night classes for adults, afternoon classes for children. Registrations are now being taken for the semester which starts Feb. 4.

Child Classes In Languages

In Spanish, French At Southwestern

New beginners classes for children in Spanish and French will be offered by Southwestern's International Language Center during the second semester, starting Feb. 4, Dr. Joe O. Embry, director, said today.

Scheduled are a Spanish class for ages 13-14-15 to meet from 4:30 until 5:30 p.m. Tuesdays and Thursdays and a French class for ages 9-10-11 at the same hour on Mondays and Wednesdays.

Other classes will be formed for any age group in any language for which there is sufficient demand, Dr. Embry said. The fee for the semester is \$30 and application or inquiry should be made at once.

The center also offers night classes for adults in French, German, Russian, Spanish and English (for foreigners) and individual instruction in some 15 other modern languages by the use of specially adapted tape recording equipment.

The center is located in Southwestern's Mallory Gymnasium. It also offers teachers, tutors, translators, and interpreters. The daytime telephone number is BR 8-1800, night BR 8-3363.

Language Classes Start Tomorrow

Southwestern's International Language Center will start new classes in Spanish for both adults and children tomorrow and classes in French Thursday.

Currently there are classes in German, Russian and English, as well as French and Spanish.

A number of students are studying Chinese, Japanese, Danish, Portugese, modern Greek, modern Hebrew, Russian, English, German, Spanish and French on tape.
