We have won a victory in the U. S. Supreme Court for parklands everywhere. Now we are returning to our homefront in order to save Overton Park -- and other parks.

The U. S. Supreme Court's unanimous decision Reversed and Remanded our case to the U. S. District Court of West Tennessee in Memphis and directed -

1. a "plenary (full) review" of Secretary Volpe's decision to approve I-40 through Overton Park,
2. "the reviewing court to engage in a substantial inquiry".

The Citizens to Preserve Overton Park now have their greatest challenge.
