Completing I-40 Record

HEARINGS on the controversial link in Interstate Highway 40, long planned through Overton Park but delayed by court order, will be held tomorrow at 10 a.m. in the City Council chamber.

This is another in the steps being taken by the federal and state transportation departments to build a complete and up-to-date record that will conform to the 1970 National Environmental Protection Act.

Many of those who have spoken at previous hearings will be there again. Because soon thereafter we hope Transportation Secretary John Volpe will make his decision and settle this question once and for all.
