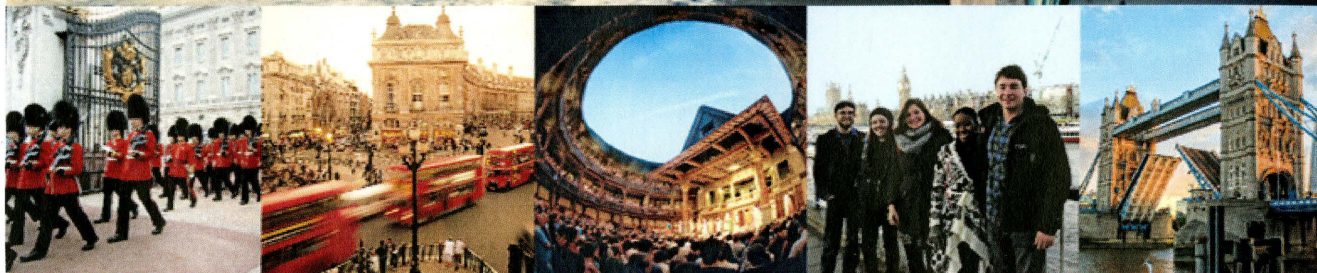


LIVE and STUDY in LONDON, ENGLAND THIS SUMMER!



Rhodes Summer School in London (formerly *British Studies*)

University of London, Goldsmiths | July 3-31, 2017

8 credits | Foundations include F1, F3, F4, F11 | Open to all majors!

Participate in this intensive four-week study abroad opportunity to learn about British literature, history, art (and more!) from ancient through contemporary times as we explore British sites, history and culture. The courses are taught by American and British professors. All students and faculty will reside at the University of London, Goldsmiths, which is only a short ride away on public transport from London's major attractions.

This immersion program includes highlighted excursions to famous sites and landmarks such as Stonehenge, the British Museum, Shakespeare's Globe Theatre, and many more. It also includes an overnight trip to Paris, France!

This program is suitable for all Rhodes students, regardless of major, and each class is transferable and includes Foundation credits. Each offered course has 4 credit hours. Students will choose two courses from a selection including Search 201, British Literature, Theatre/Shakespeare, and British History for a total of 8 credits.
