Mau Mau Detainees On Hunger Strike

NAIROBI, Kenya (NNPA) — More than 100 so-called "hard-core" Mau Mau detainees had begun a hunger strike since May 12 at Hola Camp, where 11 "detainees" died from beatings in March, a Kenya Government spokesman announced Monday (May 18).

The spokesman said a senior prisoners' officer, who visited Hola, reported that 144 "detainees" went on hunger strike on May 12. Later, 35 of them abandoned the strike.
