

Steam Boat Letter Mar 11th 1855

Col R Sopp

Dear Sir

On reflection I have thought that Mr Lane & some others we named might not be willing to subscribe the amount we put down to them as stock in the Hotel.

If Lane subscribes for 2000 dollars subscription stand as it is at the 2000 if he will not pay that amount, I wish you to reduce mine to 1000. I do not think I ought to subscribe more than Lane, Vance, and Howard. I am perfectly willing to make it as liberal as any of them in proportion to my interest, considering my upstream interest. I hope you will be able to raise a sufficient amount and pay the note under contract immediately. Please write me in a week or two what has been done. I called to see you but did not find you in and left word with Col Greaves to the above effect, in case Lane would not subscribe for 2000.
