Prof. Carl Holliday, having requested to be released from his duties as a member of the faculty in order to accept the headship of the English department at Vanderbilt University, the Executive Committee complied with his request with the understanding that the amount paid him Sept. 1 on his salary for 1910-1911 shall be returned to the University at an early date.

The committee elected for one year to the chair of English at a salary of \$1400. Prof. F. M. Darnall, instructor or assistant in the English Department of the A & M College at Starksville, Miss. Prof. Darnall having signified to Prof. Holliday that he would accept the position if offered.
