## CONCERT PARTICIPANTS

The Rhodes Singers and the Music Academy Children's Chorus share holiday music and the warmth of the season as this annual campus concert again unfolds in the refectory. Last night the Singers presented the twelfth annual 'Christmas at St. Mary's' concert at St. Mary's Episcopal Cathedral, in a festival including the Rhodes Music Academy Children's Chorus, Young Singers and Chamber Ensemble, along with the Rhodes Brass and organ.



Professor David Ramsey is serving as interim conductor of the Singers in the 1998-1999 year, following the untimely death last June of longtime Singers conductor Tony Lee Garner. Mr. Ramsey is an Associate Professor of Music and Organist-in-Residence on campus, in wide demand as a concert artist and accompanist, and Director of Music and Organist at St. John's United Methodist Church.



The Children's Chorus, numbering 50, sing twice annually at Rhodes Singers concerts, at Christmas and in the spring concert. Their director, Susan Van Dyck, an Orff music specialist at the University of Memphis Campus School, has been their energetic leader for all seven years. She is assisted by Harriet Turnbull. Both are graduates of Rhodes.
