Wednesday, November 18, 2009 -- (Meditation: John 14:27) When I complain a lot, O God, forgive me. I don't want to be a negative person. Help me to have a thankful heart, for I am so blessed. Help me to have an humble heart, for You have forgiven me. Help me to have a heart filled with the joy that comes from victorious surrender to You. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

Thursday, November 19, 2009 -- (Meditation: John 15:1-4) God, go deep to uproot the shallowness of my life. Cut deep -- to remove the selfishness of my me-centered faith. Plough deep -- to loosen the hardened sub-soil of my soul. Dig deep -- to reach living water for my parched soul. Go deep, O God, and heal the scars, so I can live each day in Your abiding love and leading. Through Jesus Christ, my Lord. Amen.

Friday, November 20, 2009 -- (Meditation: John 12:26) God, I pray for my company. Give us joy in our work together, and justice in all our dealings.
