CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

- Article I The organization shall be called the Southwestern Woman's Club.
- Article II The membership of the club shall consist of those ladies most intimately associated with the college. New members shall be received on invitation of the club.
- Article III The object of the club shall be to promote the interests of the college in any way that may seem feasible and to cultivate mutual acquaintance among the members.
- Article IV The officers of the club shall be a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Parliamentarian. Officers shall be elected to serve for two years: the President, Treasurer, and Parliamentarian being elected in one year, and the Vice-President and Secretary in the alternate year.

- Article V The annual election of officers shall be held at the April meeting. The newly elected officers shall assume their duties at the close of the school year.
- Article VI The dues shall be \$3.00 per year, payable at the first meeting in the fall.
- Article VII One third of the paid membership shall constitute a quorum.
- Article VIII The regular time for the meeting of the club shall be the first Monday in each month from October to May inclusive.
- Article IX The Constitution may be amended at any regular meeting by a majority vote of those present, provided notice of the proposed amendment has been given at the preceding meeting.

BY-LAWS

Sect. 1. The duties of the officers shall be as follows:

The President shall preside at all meetings, appoint special committees and perform such functions as are appropriate to her office.

The Vice-President shall preside in the absence of the President and shall act as chairman of special social activities.

The Secretary shall have charge of records and correspondence.

The Treasurer shall be responsible for all collections and disbursements.

The Parliamentarian shall be the authority on correct procedure.

Sect. 2 The President shall appoint the following Standing Committees:

- a. A membership committee to extend a written invitation to prospective members stating the purpose and program of the club.
- b. A Ways and Means Committee to sponsor projects of mutual interest to the club and its members.
- c. A committee to send expressions of Congratulations and Condolence as occasions arise.

Sect. 3 The By-Laws may be altered or amended at any regular meeting by a majority of those present.
