Report of the Divinity School of the Southwestern Presbyterian University

The death of Rev. W. A. Aldexander, D.D., professor of Biblical Languages and Literature, was a sad loss to the Divinity School and the University. The work, however, was carried on without more than a few days interruption, by the other members of the Faculty, and by Rev. C.E. Diehl, pastor of the church, who taught the classes in Hebrew. The chair was filled in March by the Rev. C.W. Sommerville, D.D., who resigned the pastorate of the Cresent Hill church in Louisville to devote himself to the work.

There are ten students in the Divinity School, four in the Junior class, and six in the Senior, there being only two classes in the course because of the longer time given to the work each session than is usual in seminaries.

Those expecting to complete the full work of the Senior course this session are Mr. James Marion Staffor, of the Presbytery of North Alabama; Mr. Franklin Crane Talmage, of the Presbytery of New Orleans; and Mr. General Henry Trupin of Colombia Presbytery. Those expecting to complete part of the work of the Senior course are Mr. Samuel Eugene Crosby, of Mobile Presbytery; Mr. Abel Auchmoody Du Bois, of Nashville Presbytery; and Mr. Paul Eve Taliafero, of the Presbytery of Western District.
