HONORARY DEGREES TO BE CONFERRED

Ellett, McKellar, Landis and Miss McGaughey

Southwestern will confer four honorary degrees at its ninety-third annual Commencement on May 26.

Dr. E. C. Ellett of Memphis, prominent Memphis eye specialist, will receive the degree of Doctor of Laws. Dr. Ellett attended Southwestern from 1884 to 1886, the University of the South, and graduated from the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine in 1891. A member of many medical societies and organizations, Dr. Ellett has practiced in Memphis for nearly forty years. He was a Lt. Colonel in the Medical Corps during the first World War, and for many years served on the faculty of the University of Tennessee College of Medicine. Internationally recognized as preeminent in his field, Dr. Ellett last year was awarded the Leslie Dana gold medal for "outstanding achievement in the prevention of blindness and conservation of sight."

The Honorable K. D. McKellar, Senior United States Senator from Tennessee will also receive the degree of Doctor of Laws. Senator McKellar was elected to Congress in 1911, and has represented Tennessee in the Senate since 1917. Active in the affairs of his party, and widely known for his devotion to public duty, Senator McKellar is recognized as one of the most outstanding statesmen in the United States Congress at the present time. Mr. McKellar attended the University of Alabama, and graduated from the Law School of that Institution in 1892.

The degree of Doctor of Religious Education will be conferred upon Mr. R. L. Landis, Director of Religious Education for the Presbyterian Synod of Mississippi. A native of Tennessee, Mr. Landis graduated from Lincoln Jefferson University and studied at several theological seminaries and religious leadership training schools. After working for a number of years in the field of high school and college education, in 1920 Mr. Landis became Director of Religious Education for the Presbyterian Church, U. S., in the Synod of Mississippi. His service in this capacity during the past twenty-two years has been marked by many outstanding achievements.

Miss Janie Wood McGaughey of Atlanta will also be granted the degree of Doctor of Religious Education. A graduate of Agnes Scott College, Miss McGaughey has served on the faculties of several educational institutions. Since 1929 she has been Secretary for the Woman's Work of the Presbyterian Church in the United States. Miss McGaughey is the author of several books on religious subjects, and is a frequent contributor to church papers.

ALFRED NOYES TO ADDRESS NINETY-THIRD COMMENCEMENT

Exercises Tuesday, May 26th

Mr. Alfred Noyes, the distinguished English poet and lecturer, will deliver the address at Southwestern's Ninety-third Commencement, Tuesday, May 26.

Born and educated in England, Mr. Noyes' literary career began soon after his graduation from Oxford University. His fame has grown with each passing year until today he is among the most popular and best-loved poets in the English speaking countries of the world.

Among the many volumes of Alfred Noyes' verse are "The Golden Hynde," "The Elfin Artist," "Sherwood," "The Enchanted Island," "Beyond the Desert," and "The Torch Bearer." Noyes has written many poems dealing with American subjects. Ex-President Taft made the statement that Mr. Noyes was "one of the great poets of this generation" in his treatment of war and peace, and his expression of hope that we all hold for the future of a world set free from wars.

Mr. Noyes served in the British Foreign Office during the first World War and in 1918 was made a Commander of the Order of the British Empire. For a number of years he was Visiting Professor of English at Princeton University, and he has addressed numerous college and university audiences while on lecture tours of this country.

Repeated Nazi bombardments of his home on the Isle of Wight brought Mr. Noyes and his family into temporary exile in Canada the latter part of the summer of 1940. There he toured the Dominion for the National Council on Education prior to coming to the United States.

Others to Attend Seminary

Of the thirty-one men who will receive degrees from Southwestern on May 26, twenty-four have definite plans as to what they will do after graduation. Twelve of the thirty-one have already been accepted as prospective officers by various branches of the military service and will immediately enter officers training schools—one in the Marine Corps, one in Naval Aviation, eight in Navy Deck Officers School, one in the Coast Guard, and one in Army Supply.

Seven other members of the class of '42 will enter theological seminary. This is a larger number than for several years past.

Four members of the senior class are entering the field of medicine, three of them already having started their medical education. All four of these men, of course, will enter either the Naval or Army Medical Corps on completion of their medical training.

Because of their specialized scientific training, it is probable that several of the men in the senior class whose plans are not yet definite will enter vital defense industries.

WAR BULLETIN PUBLISHED

A special Southwestern bulletin entitled "War Courses and the Accelerated Program" has just been published. The bulletin describes college courses and programs open to young men who wish to qualify themselves for the many positions in military or war industry services which are open to those who have had the proper college training.

SOUTHWESTERN RECEIVES \$2,500 IN WAR BONDS

Gift of Mrs. J. T. Wurtsbaugh

A gift of \$2,500 in Series "G" War Bonds was received by Southwestern recently from Mrs. J. T. Wurtsbaugh of Shreveport, Louisiana. A year ago, Mrs. Wurtsbaugh made a cash gift of the same amount for the establishment of a scholarship at Southwestern. The War Bonds which were given recently pay the College semi-annual interest and this income is to be used as a student loan fund. By making her generous contribution in the form of bonds, Mrs. Wurtsbaugh is doing double duty. Not only does the purchase of bonds aid in the prosecution of the war, but by giving the securities to Southwestern, and devoting the income to education of deserving young men and women, a contribution is made to winning the peace as well.

PROSPECT FOR LARGE SUMMER SESSION Term Opens June 1

The Southwestern summer Session this year will be the largest according to present indications. Under the "accelerated" program which was adopted by Southwestern soon after the declaration of war last December, the College is now on a twelve month basis with nearly a full semester of work being offered in the summer semester. By attending summer as well as winter terms, capable students may graduate in two years and eight months, according to the present schedule. This makes it possible for many young men to start their college program with a reasonable expectation of completing the degree requirements before reaching draft age.

It is expected that a great many high school seniors will enter Southwestern in June rather than waiting until next September, in order to take advantage of the new accelerated schedule.

NAVY PROGRAM KEEPS MEN IN COLLEGE

Under a program just announced, a young man entering college can enlist in the Navy and be immediately given inactive status so as to be permitted to attend college for at least two, and possibly four years. In order to do this, however, he must enroll in a college which offers a special course of study approved by the Navy. Southwestern is one of the colleges which has been approved for this program.

According to this plan, the students will take a comprehensive examination along toward the end of the second year of college. On the basis of this examination, some of them will be allowed to complete four years of college, and will then enter training to become Ensigns in the Navy. Others will enter training to become Navy Aviation Officers at the end of their sophomore year. Still others will be transferred to active duty after completion of the sophomore year.

Under this program, men between 18 and 26 who are enrolled as full time students at Southwestern may be enlisted as privates in the Air Force Enlisted Reserve and be placed on a deferred basis to continue their college courses until graduation. On graduation, these men will be assigned to duty as Aviation Cadets to train to become aviation officers as training facilities become available. Opportunities for commissions are open in both the flying and in ground crew divisions.
