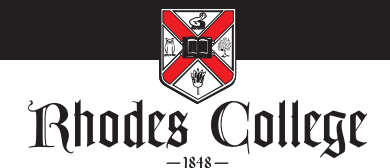

An academic internship allows your organization to host a Rhodes intern for 10 hours per week (unpaid) for one semester (approximately 140 total hours). Students earn credit that can be applied toward graduation.
